

FOX Business Made In America Awards Contest 2026
Official Rules

- **VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.**
- **ALL DISPUTES WILL BE RESOLVED SOLELY BY BINDING ARBITRATION AND ENTRANTS WAIVE THE ABILITY TO BRING CLAIMS IN A CLASS ACTION FORMAT.**
- **THIS IS A NOMINATION STYLE CONTEST. THE INDIVIDUAL NOMINATING A BUSINESS IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO WIN ANY PRIZE.**

BY ENTERING (OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATING IN) THE CONTEST, YOU AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, WHICH ARE A BINDING CONTRACT, SO READ THEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING. WITHOUT LIMITATION, THIS CONTRACT INCLUDES INDEMNITIES TO THE CONTEST PARTIES FROM YOU AND A LIMITATION OF YOUR RIGHTS AND REMEDIES.

1. **CONTEST DESCRIPTION:** The FOX Business Made In America Awards Contest 2026 (“**Contest**”) is sponsored by Fox News Network, LLC begins on or about March 12, 2026 at 12:01 pm Eastern Time (“**ET**”) and is scheduled to end on May 4, 2026 (the “**Contest Period**”). During the Contest Period, the following stages are scheduled to take place:

- **Entry Period:** Eligible participants will have the opportunity to enter a “Submission” (as defined below) to nominate an eligible small business to win a prize during the period that begins on or about March 12, 2026 at 12:01 pm ET and ends on the earlier of: (i) March 30, 2026 at 11:59 am ET or (ii) when 10,000 Submissions have been received (the “**Entry Period**”). Individual entrants who submit a Submission are referred to in these Official Rules as the “**Nominator**”; businesses that are nominated to participate in the Contest are each referred to herein as an “**Eligible Business**”.
- **Initial Judging Period:** At the end of the Entry Period, all eligible Submissions received will be reviewed by a judging panel to select up to ten (10) “Finalists” (as defined below) beginning on or about March 31, 2026 and ending on or about April 13, 2026 (the “**Initial Judging Period**”).
- **Public Voting Period:** At the end of the Initial Judging Period, the Finalists’ Submissions will be published on the “Website” (as defined below) and users will have the opportunity to vote on Submissions beginning on or about April 13, 2026 at 12:01 pm ET and ending on April 20, 2026 at 11:59 am ET (the “**Public Voting Period**”).
- **Final Judging Period:** At the end of the Public Voting Period, the judging panel will evaluate the Finalists’ Submissions to select up to three (3) grand prize winners and up to seven (7) first prize winners, beginning on April 21, 2026 and ending on or about May 4, 2026 (the “**Final Judging Period**”).
- **Winner Announcement:** The winners are scheduled to be announced on or about May 4, 2026 at approximately 12:00 pm ET.

By participating in the Contest, each participant unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of FOX News Network, LLC, 1211 Avenue of the Americas, New York, NY 10036 (“**Sponsor**”), which shall be final and binding in all respects.

2. **ELIGIBILITY:**

- A. **Nominator Eligibility.** Only legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia, who are eighteen (18) years of age or older as of the date of entry are eligible to participate in the Contest as Nominators. Officers, directors, and employees of Sponsor, Realtime Media LLC (“**Administrator**”) and each of their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, distributors, retailers, sales representatives, advertising and promotion agencies involved in the Contest (all such individuals and entities collectively referred to herein as the “**Contest Parties**”), and the immediate family members and those living in the same household as such individuals (whether legally related or not), are not eligible to participate in the Contest or win a prize. For purposes of this Contest, immediate family members are defined as spouse, partner, parents, legal guardians, in-laws, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren and their respective spouses, and those living in the same household shall mean people who share the same

residence at least three (3) months a year, whether legally related or not. This Contest is void where prohibited by law. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply.

B. Eligible Business Eligibility Criteria. Eligible Businesses must be a business that is (i) registered to conduct business in one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia; (ii) independently owned and operated, sole-proprietor, non-franchised, and not part of any other established parent or partner business(es); (iii) founded and operates in the United States; (iv) engaged in active operations as of the start of the Contest Period; (v) employs five hundred or fewer full-time employees as of the start of the Contest Period; (vi) generates \$7.5 million dollars or less in annual revenue; (v) maintains commercial operations through May 4, 2026; and (vi) cannot operate in the following categories: businesses owned by private equity, independent businesses that operate a franchise location of a national or regional brand; cannabis, CBD, tobacco, or vape products; adult entertainment; gambling or betting; personal loans; non-profit organizations; any business with a political or advocacy focus; psychics, mediums, or card readers; or any other category that Sponsor determines is objectionable.

3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE: During the Entry Period, eligible Nominators will have the opportunity to nominate an Eligible Business to be considered for the Contest. If an Eligible Business is selected to advance in the Contest, the Eligible Business must agree to participate and accept the terms and conditions of these Official Rules. Owners and employees of Eligible Businesses are authorized to submit the Eligible Business they own or work for so long as such business meets the eligibility criteria. Before nominating an Eligible Business, each Nominator should confirm that an Eligible Business is willing to participate in the Contest and agree to these Official Rules.

During the Entry Period, eligible Nominators must either (a) create an original video up to sixty seconds (:60) in length in one of the following formats: MPG, MP4, MOV, WMV, AVI (the “**Video**”); or (b) write an original essay of up to 3,000 characters in length that describes an Eligible Business and why that Eligible Business helps make America what it is today (the “**Essay**”). Each Video or Essay should (a) describe an Eligible Business and why that Eligible Business helps make America what it is today, by focusing on the following aspects: (i) Leadership and Team Culture (vision and value of leadership, the spirit of the small business); (ii) Innovation and Creativity (new products and services, willingness to adapt); (iii) Customer Experience and Loyalty; and (iv) Community Impact; and (b) must comply with the “Submission Requirements” (as defined below).

To nominate an Eligible Business for the Contest, visit <https://SmallBusinessAwards2026.com> (“**Website**”) during the Entry Period and follow the instructions on screen to complete the entry form (the “**Entry Form**”) with all required information, including your contact information (full name, phone number, and email address), contact information for the Eligible Business (including name, complete street address, phone number, and first and last name of the designated representative for the Eligible Business, and state in which the Eligible Business it is registered [if known]), the official website for the Eligible Business, plus any other relevant social medial accounts and/or other online presence. Then, follow the instructions to upload your Video or Essay. The completed Entry Form and each Nominator’s Video or Essay are collectively referred to herein as the “**Submission**”. By submitting the Submission, the Eligible Business will be entered into the Contest.

The Submission must meet the following “**Submission Requirements**”: (i) the Submission must be the Nominator’s original, previously unpublished work and not feature or focus on any copyrighted material, logos or trademarks that are owned by third parties, other than those of the Eligible Business; (ii) the Nominator should either be the only person who appears in the Submission or, if anyone else appears in the Submission, the Nominator must obtain written permission from that person or those people to include them in the video, and if Sponsor asks to see the written permissions, the Nominator must provide them upon request (in the event a Nominator cannot provide permissions that are satisfactory to Sponsor, in its sole and absolute discretion, Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify the applicable Submission, or seek to secure the releases and clearances for Sponsor’s own benefit, or otherwise allow the applicable Submission to remain in Contest); and (iii) the Submission must not include images

content, or language that are deemed by the Sponsor to be obscene, pornographic, libelous or otherwise objectionable.

By submitting a Submission, each Nominator warrants and represents that the Nominator consents to the use of the Submission in the Contest, to its publication for public voting if selected as a Finalist in this Contest, and to its use as otherwise set forth herein.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Once a Submission is uploaded to the Website it may be made available for viewing on the Website for viewing by the general public and any such posting will be deemed made at the direction of the Nominator. Any entrant who incorporates any intellectual property owned by a third party into a Submission does so at his or her own risk. Without in any way limiting, expanding or amending the terms and conditions residing on the Website, which terms and conditions shall remain in full force and effect, if Sponsor is duly notified that any element of a Submission infringes upon the rights of another person and/or receives a legally valid request to remove the affected Submission from the Website because of such infringement, such Submission may be disqualified from the Contest, as Sponsor may determine in its sole discretion.

The Contest Parties are not responsible for technical difficulties of any kind, or for false, incorrect, changed, incomplete or illegible contact information.

LIMIT: Each Nominator is only permitted to submit one (1) Submission per Eligible Business. Nominators can submit an unlimited number of Submissions so long as each Submission is for a different Eligible Business. Eligible Businesses can be the subject of multiple Submissions, provided that each Submission was submitted by different Nominators. All Submissions must be received by the end of the Entry Period. No substitutions or new versions of Submissions will be accepted once the original Submission is submitted for consideration. Any Submission that is considered by Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion to violate the Submission Requirements, in whole or in part, may be disqualified and will not be eligible for entry and may be disqualified.

Attempts made by the same Nominator to earn more than the stated number of Submissions by using multiple or false contact information, accounts or otherwise may result in disqualification. Submissions generated by (or suspected to be generated by) artificial intelligence, script, computer programs, macro, programmed, robotic or other automated means are void and may be disqualified. Submissions that are in excess of the stated limit(s), incomplete, illegible, corrupted, damaged, destroyed, forged, false, lost, late or misdirected, deceptive, or otherwise not in compliance with the Official Rules may be disqualified from the Contest at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. Those who do not follow all instructions, provide the required information in their Entry Form, or abide by these Official Rules or other instructions of Sponsor may be disqualified. Submissions submitted by Nominators who do not meet the eligibility requirements (including all requirements with respect to age and residence) or for businesses that are not Eligible Businesses are void. In the event of a dispute over the identity of a Nominator, the Submission will be deemed submitted by the registered account holder of the email address associated with the Submission, provided that person is eligible. Registered account holder is defined as the person assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses. In the event that a dispute regarding the identity of the individual who submitted a Submission cannot be resolved to Sponsor's satisfaction, the affected Submission will be deemed ineligible.

- 4. RIGHTS IN SUBMISSIONS:** For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and legal sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, each Nominator irrevocably grants to the Contest Parties, and each of their respective licensees, successors and assigns, the non-exclusive, perpetual, royalty-free, license and right (but not the obligation) to reproduce, publicly perform, publicly display, stream, exploit, make derivative works of and otherwise use the Submission, in whole or in part, for any purpose, including without limitation commercial purposes, in any and all media now or hereafter devised throughout the universe in perpetuity. The Contest Parties shall have the right, in their sole discretion, to edit, composite, morph, scan, duplicate, or alter the Submission for any purpose which the Contest Parties deem necessary or desirable, and each Nominator irrevocably waives any and all so-called "moral

rights” they may have therein. The Contest Parties shall retain the rights granted in each Submission even if the Submission is disqualified or fails to meet the Submission Requirements or even if it is determined that the Nominator who made the Submission or the business featured in the Submission is ineligible to enter the Contest.

You acknowledge that Entries are not being submitted in confidence or in trust to Sponsor, and that no confidential or fiduciary relationship is intended or created. By submitting an Entry, you acknowledge and agree that Sponsor may receive other Entries under this Contest that may be similar or identical to the Entry submitted by you, and you waive any and all claims you may have had, may have, and/or may have in the future, that any other Entry reviewed and/or used by Sponsor may be similar to your Entry and you understand that you will not be entitled to any compensation because of Sponsor's use of such other similar or identical material. Notwithstanding any custom and practice in the industry to pay an individual for an idea (if any), nothing herein shall create an implied or express contract to compensate entrants for their Entries and there is no obligation for any Contest Party to pay or otherwise compensate entrants for any of their ideas or materials in any communications with Sponsor, whatsoever. Entries are not confidential, and the Contest Parties' only obligations to entrants regarding Entries are as specifically set forth in these Official Rules. The decisions of the Sponsor are final and binding in all matters relating to this Contest, including interpretation and application of these Official Rules. By participating in the Contest, except where legally prohibited, you grant permission for the Contest Parties and their respective designees to use your name, address (city and state), nominated Business information, photograph, video, voice and/or other likeness and prize information for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without further compensation, in all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide in perpetuity, without notice or review or approval. The Contest Parties reserve the right to request at any time proof you maintain all necessary rights in your Entry in order to grant the Contest Parties the rights required herein in a form acceptable to the Contest Parties. Failure to provide such proof may lead to, among other things, disqualification from the Contest.

- 5. NATURE OF RELATIONSHIP/WAIVER OF EQUITABLE RELIEF:** Each Nominator hereby acknowledges and agrees that the relationship between the Nominator and the Contest Parties is not a confidential, fiduciary, or other special relationship, and that the Nominator's decision to provide the Submission (if applicable) to Sponsor for purposes of the Contest does not place the Contest Parties in a position that is any different from the position held by members of the general public with regard to elements of the entrant's Submission. Each Nominator understands and acknowledges that the Contest Parties have wide access to ideas, stories, designs, and other literary materials, and that new ideas are constantly being submitted to the Contest Parties or being developed by their own employees. Each Nominator also acknowledges that many ideas may be competitive with, similar or identical to the Submission, may feature the same Eligible Business and/or each other in theme, idea, plot, format, or other respects. Each Nominator acknowledges and agrees that such Nominator will not be entitled to any compensation as a result of any Contest Party's use of any such similar or identical material. Each Nominator acknowledges and agrees that the Contest Parties do not now and shall not have in the future any duty or liability, direct or indirect, vicarious, contributory, or otherwise, with respect to the infringement or protection of the copyright in and to the Submission. Finally, each Nominator acknowledges that, with respect to any claim by Nominator relating to or arising out of a Contest Party's actual or alleged exploitation or use of any Submission or other material submitted in connection with the Contest, the damage, if any, thereby caused to the applicable entrant will not be irreparable or otherwise sufficient to entitle such Nominator to seek injunctive or other equitable relief and Nominator's rights and remedies in any such event shall be strictly limited to the right to recover damages, if any, in an action at law.
- 6. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES:** By entering the Contest, each Nominator represents and warrants that the Nominator has read, understand, agrees to and will follow the Official Rules. Each Nominator further represents and warrants that the Submission and all materials and matter therein: (a) (except for elements that are within the public domain or are provided by Sponsor for inclusion in Entries, or the logo or name of the Eligible Business) are wholly original to the Nominator and are not a copy or imitation of any other material or you have all necessary rights to grant the Sponsor the rights granted hereunder and exercise such without obligation or liability to any third party; (b) will not infringe

or violate any right whatsoever, including, without limitation, any personal rights (e.g., defamation, privacy, right of publicity, false light, moral right, etc.) or any property rights (e.g., copyright, trademark, right to ideas, etc.) of any person or entity and the use thereof will result in no third-party liability or obligations; and (c) is not the subject of any threatened or pending litigation, claim or dispute that might give rise to litigation, which adversely affects or in any way prejudices, impairs or diminishes the rights granted hereunder or the value thereof. Each Nominator further represents and warrants that the Nominator has the right to agree to and fully perform consistent with these Official Rules and that Nominator has complied and has obtained all permissions, licenses and consents that are necessary for the Submission and the use of the Submission and to verify compliance with the foregoing requirements. Each Nominator agrees to indemnify the Contest Parties and hold them harmless from and against any and all third party claims, liability, judgments, losses, damages, costs, and expenses, including penalties, interest and reasonable outside attorney's fees and costs in the defense and disposition of such matters arising out of, resulting from, based upon or incurred because of a breach or allegation that, if true, would constitute a breach by Nominator of its representations, warranties, covenants or obligations hereunder, including, without limitation, any action or statement made by the Nominator while participating in the Contest.

7. **NO OBLIGATION TO USE:** The Contest Parties shall have no obligation (express or implied) to use any Submission, or to otherwise exploit any Submission or, if commenced, to continue the distribution or exploitation thereof, and the Contest Parties may at any time abandon the use of the Submission for any reason, with or without legal justification or excuse, and entrants shall not be entitled to any damages or other relief by reason thereof.
8. **INITIAL JUDGING PERIOD:** Assuming a sufficient number of eligible Submissions are received, at the end of the Entry Period, a judge or group of judges selected by Sponsor in its sole discretion (in either case, the "**Judging Panel**") will review the Submissions that have been received and select up to ten (10) finalists (each, a "**Finalist**") during the Initial Judging Period based on the following criteria:
 - 25%: Leadership and Team Culture (vision and value of leadership, the spirit of the small business)
 - 25%: Innovation and Creativity (new products and services, willingness to adapt)
 - 25%: Customer Experience and Loyalty
 - 25%: Community Impact

Decisions of the Judging Panel are final and not subject to appeal. Each Eligible Business that is selected as Finalist must, through an authorized representative (the "**Authorized Representative**"), verify that the Eligible Business is willing to participate in the next phase of the Contest and agree to these Official Rules on behalf of the Eligible Business. In the event an Eligible Business selected as a Finalist declines such invitation or does not respond within the stated period, the Judging Panel will select the next highest scoring Submission. In the event of any ties in determining the position of a Finalist, a tie-breaking judge will score all tied Entries based on the criteria set forth above, and the Entry with the highest tie-breaking judge's score will prevail.

Sponsor reserves the right to choose fewer than ten (10) Finalists if, in its sole discretion, it does not receive a sufficient number or quality of eligible and qualified Entries.

9. **FINALIST CONFIRMATION & CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:** The Authorized Representative for each Eligible Business selected as a Finalist must sign and return a participation agreement (the "**Participation Agreement**"), which confirms the Eligible Business' agreement to participate in the Contest and to the Official Rules, which grants the Contest Parties a license to use the Eligible Business' name, trademark, logo, and all other materials provided by the Eligible Business to the Contest Parties to the full extent contemplated herein. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of the Participation Agreement and the terms and conditions of these Official Rules, the terms and conditions of the Participation Agreement shall prevail, govern, and control. Each potential Finalist through its Authorized Representative will be required to acknowledge and agree that Sponsor and/or its authorized agent or designee may conduct a full background check

on the potential Finalist, the Authorized Representative, and the executives of the Eligible Business prior to the start of the Public Voting Period, and each potential Finalist will consent to such background check and will be required to acknowledge that such background check may include (but is not limited to) investigation of employment history, criminal or other arrest or conviction record, and any other factor deemed relevant by Sponsor to help ensure that the potential Finalist's participation in the Contest and/or the featuring the Finalist as contemplated herein will not, in Sponsor's sole discretion, bring Sponsor into public disrepute, contempt, scandal or ridicule or reflect unfavorably on Sponsor. Sponsor may disqualify any potential Finalist based on the results of the background check, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. In the event that any potential Finalist is disqualified as a result of the results of a background check, an alternate Finalist may be selected. Sponsor also reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to disqualify any individual who has been charged with or convicted of a felony or misdemeanor, is delinquent on child support, spousal support, tax payments or any other government ordered payment, has or is suspected of failing to comply with any provision of these Official Rules, including, but not limited to, having made any false statements in connection with his/her participation in the Contest. Should it be determined that a potential Finalist or its Authorized Representative has made a false statement in any document required by Sponsor, Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify the potential Finalist and select an alternate Finalist.

- 10. PUBLIC VOTING:** During the Public Voting Period, legal residents of the fifty (50) United States or District of Columbia, who are eighteen (18) years of age at the time of voting, will have the opportunity to vote on the Submission they believe "makes America what it is today". To place a vote for a Finalist, eligible users must visit the Website during the Public Voting Period and follow the on-screen instructions to register with the Website. Upon submitting the required information, the user will be able to place one (1) vote for the Submission that the user believes "makes America what it is today". **Nominators are permitted to vote during the Public Voting Period.** All participants in this Contest are prohibited from casting, soliciting, or obtaining votes by any fraudulent or inappropriate means, including, without limitation, offering prizes, payments, or other inducements to members of the public (including, without limitation, offering to trade their vote), as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion and all associated votes may be void and such Finalists may be disqualified. Any suspected or deliberate attempt to manipulate or otherwise fraudulently tamper with the voting process may result in disqualification of any Finalist, at the Sponsor's sole discretion. Votes generated by script, macro, bot, artificial intelligence agent, vote-swapping sites, voting software, entering service sites, or other automated means or and votes by any means that subvert the voting process or do not conform to the spirit of these Official Rules will void the applicable votes and may disqualify the applicable Finalist. Any attempt to exceed the limited number of votes shall give the Sponsor the right to void the votes in question and potentially to disqualify the applicable Finalist, at its sole discretion. Votes for each Submission may be tracked by the Website. Any rankings or vote counts posted on the Website are unofficial and should not be relied upon for any purpose. In the event that Sponsor determines that the voting mechanism has been tampered with or otherwise manipulated, Sponsor reserves the right to cancel the voting portion of the Contest or to cancel the Contest. **Limit of one (1) vote per person per calendar day based on ET, throughout the entire Voting Period. There are no prizes for voting.**
- 11. FINAL JUDGING PERIOD AND WINNER DETERMINATION:** At the end of the Public Voting Period, the Judging Panel will select three (3) grand prize winners and seven (7) first prize winners using the Judging Criteria and the number of votes the Submission featuring the Finalist receives. The potential winners will be subject to verification and compliance with these Official Rules.

In the event of any ties in determining the position of a winner, a tie-breaking judge will score all tied Entries based on the criteria set forth above, and the Entry with the highest tie-breaking judge's score will prevail. If any Finalist is found to be ineligible or does not comply with these Official Rules, the Finalist will be disqualified and the Finalist with the next highest score will be named the winner of the applicable prize. Administrator's, Judges', and Sponsor's decisions shall be final and binding in all matters pertaining to the judging and selection of the winners.

Sponsor reserves the right not to award all prizes if, in its sole discretion, a Finalist is disqualified or otherwise unable to accept a prize.

No more than the stated number of prizes will be awarded. If, for any reason, more bona fide winners come forward seeking to claim prizes in excess of the number of each type of prize set forth in these Official Rules, the winner(s) of the advertised number of prizes available may be selected by using the judging process outlined above among any entrant making purportedly valid claims for such prize(s). Inclusion in such process shall be each entrant's sole and exclusive remedy under such circumstances.

- 12. WINNER NOTIFICATION/PRIZE CLAIMING:** The potential winners will be notified through their Authorized Representative via email (or other contact information) using the information provided at the time of Finalist confirmation in a commercially reasonable time after the determination of the winners. The Contest Parties are not responsible for and shall not be liable for incorrect, changed, or illegible contact information or for electronic communications that are undeliverable as a result of any form of active or passive filtering, or insufficient space in the recipient's email or other account to receive messages. Contest Parties are not responsible for late, lost, intercepted, misdirected, or unsuccessful efforts to notify a potential winner or its Authorized Representative. Notification is deemed to have occurred immediately upon the sending of an email. If a potential winner or their Authorized Representative cannot be contacted within a reasonable time period, if a potential winner or their business is ineligible, if any notification is returned undeliverable, or if a potential winner or their Authorized Representative otherwise fails to fully comply with these Official Rules, such potential winner will forfeit that prize. As part of the winner notification process, each potential grand prize winner will be required to complete and submit (through their Authorized Representative) a declaration of eligibility/release of liability/prize acceptance agreement ("**Declaration**"), within three (3) days of date of notification, as a condition of receiving a grand prize. If any potential grand prize winner fails or refuses to sign and return the Declaration within the required time period or if the Declaration is returned as rejected, faulty, unclaimed or returned as undeliverable to potential winner, and/or the potential grand prize winner is otherwise noncompliant, the potential grand prize winner will be disqualified and an alternate will be selected using the judging process set forth above. A potential winner becomes a "winner" only after verification of eligibility by Sponsor.

- 13. PRIZES/PRIZE RESTRICTIONS:** The prizes to be awarded in this Contest are:
